LOCATION:

The lots are located in the Brooklyn Park neighborhood of northern Anne Arundel County. The property is located in an established subdivision that comprises primarily single family homes built in the 1950's and early 2000's. A half mile from Governor Ritchie Highway, the lots are convenient to multiple grocery stores, restaurants, cafes, retail stores and more. The lots are equidistant from both I-895 and I-695, both major commuting routes in the surrounding area. Several large employers are located nearby including BWI Airport, NSA, the Maryland Cruise Terminal and several local industrial employers within the community. According to the Anne Arundel County Public Schools locator, the area schools are Park Elementary School, Brooklyn Park Middle School and North County High School.

The auction presents an opportunity to purchase five unimproved lots in an established neighborhood. Anne Arundel County has issued new address numbers to the lots giving purchasers the opportunity to sell the lots individually, build on them or expand on their existing lot size. All of the lots will be sold as an entirety under one auction.

ZONING:

All parcels contain both R5 (Residential) and OS (Open Space) zoning

According to the Anne Arundel County Zoning District Summaries:

R5 - Residential

This District is generally intended for low-medium density residential development at an urban density of 5 dwelling units per acre. Minimum lot size is 10,000 square feet (no public sewer) 5,000 square feet (public sewer). Maximum lot coverage by structures is 65%. Maximum height is 50 feet for a principal structure.

OS – Open Space District

The Open Space District is designed to protect and preserve those open land areas of the County used for recreation (e.g. parks) and natural areas such as bogs, wetlands, stream/creek ravines and flood plains. Farming and recreational type uses are permitted. Existing residential dwellings are also allowed, however new residential dwellings are not.

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PURCHASING REAL ESTATE AT AUCTION

The following information is provided by A. J. Billig & Co., Auctioneers to assist you in understanding your purchase of a property at public auction. The material in this form is general in nature and does not limit your obligations under the contract of sale that you will be required to sign.

TERMS OF SALE: Your responsibilities as a purchaser have been advertised prior to the day of sale and will be read by the Auctioneer at the time of sale. Additional terms may be announced on the day of sale or may be posted at the sale site. The auctioneer will make important announcements regarding the property and your obligations as a purchaser. Please feel free to ask any questions regarding these terms. Failure to comply with any of the terms of sale may cause you to forfeit your deposit and be responsible for the expenses to resell the property, as well as any deficiency incurred.

CONDITION OF PROPERTY: The property will be sold "AS IS." Unless otherwise announced, the sellers make no representations or warranties about the condition of the property. The sellers will not make any repairs.

DEPOSIT: Your deposit will be credited toward the purchase price. If you do not comply with the "TERMS OF SALE," either published or within the contract of sale, you might lose all or part of your deposit. In addition, if you fail to settle for the property you might be obligated to pay the expenses to resell the property, including any deficiency resulting therefrom. If the "TERMS OF SALE" require you to increase your deposit above the amount specified, the Auctioneer will likely accept your personal or business check for the difference on the day of sale. Otherwise, you can bring, wire or messenger certified funds for the increased deposit within the time stated.

EXPENSES: You may be responsible for the expenses of owning the property as of the date of sale or as of the date of settlement, including taxes, utility costs and insurance. You may be required to pay interest on the amount of the purchase price, less the amount of your deposit, from the date of the sale to the date you settle for the property. We recommend that you obtain a fire insurance binder on the property immediately as of the date of sale. The purchaser will pay all of the settlement expenses, including title fees and recording costs.

SETTLEMENT: The settlement or closing period is specified within the terms of sale. If settlement is based on ratification by a Court, the ratification period is typically forty-five to sixty days, but might take longer. You will be expected to settle for the property within the specified time.

FINANCING: It is the purchaser's responsibility to obtain financing. If you plan to use a mortgage to purchase the property, we recommend that you apply for the loan immediately. If the bank must take longer than the specified time to complete the loan, the sellers may extend settlement for a short period if you can provide proof of a loan commitment. If you do not obtain the financing within the specified time for settlement, you will be in default of your contract of sale.

BIDDING PROCEDURE: At the conclusion of the announcement and question period, the auctioneer will solicit bids for the property. Bids are generally made either orally or by raising a hand. Bidding increments are made in amounts acceptable to the auctioneer, who may set a minimum bidding increment as the sale progresses. Any bid that is merely a nominal or fractional advance may be rejected by the auctioneer if in his judgement it may affect the sale injuriously. If a dispute arises between two or more bidders, the auctioneer shall decide in favor of one of the bidders, or immediately re-offer the property.

REGISTERING TO BID

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE BIDDING

- The online bidding screen will display information such as time left in the auction, starting bid, and your personal max bid (if you have placed a max bid). Once bidding has started, there is a tab for bids which will show all the bids that have been placed.
- 2. To place a new bid, click the red button which displays the current asking amount.
- 3. To bid a custom amount, click the arrow at the right of the bid button and choose: Bid a specific amount.
- 4. Once a bid amount is entered, the system will prompt you to confirm the amount that you offered. Click Confirm Bid to place your bid.
- 5. To place a max bid before the auction begins, click on the prebid button and enter the maximum amount that you plan on offering for the property. The system will autobid for you up to that point. If you would like to place a max bid while the auction is live, click the arrow at the right of the bid button and choose: Create maxbid.
